Coach Eagan entered her 2nd year as the Lady Panthers head coach in the 21-22 season and her 13th year overall as a head coach. In her first year as the head coach she was named the WBCA DII Coach of the Year while guiding the Lady Panthers to 24-2 record winning the GLVC Tournament, Midwest Regional Tournament and finishing the year as the NCAA DII National Runner-Up. Prior to Drury she was the head coach at Truman State. In six seasons, she became the program's all-time leader in wins & winning percentage (111-62). In 2018-19, she led Truman to a 23-8 record, and a NCAA-II tournament appearance. In 2014, she guided Truman to a GLVC championship, and a NCAA-II tournament birth. She has coached 1 NCAA Player of the year, 1 GLVC Player of the Year, 13 All-conference players, 2 Freshman of the Year selections, and coached 5 All-GLVC Tourn. picks. Eagan had also had a stellar playing career at Truman State being named to the HOF in 2012 and playing professionally overseas in Norway after her collegiate days.

Coach Roller entered her 2nd yr. as a Lady Panthers Asst. Coach. The Lady Panther alumnae comes back to Drury after spending 4 years at Pittsburg State as an Asst. Coach (2yrs) and a GA (2yrs.) As a Lady Panther she was part of 2 NCAA-II tournaments, 2 GLVC West Division championships, and the 2015 GLVC title. Roller ranked in the top 10 in the GLVC for assists and free throw percentage and she was on the natl. leaderboard in assist-to-turnover ratio during her 2 seasons at Drury.

Coach Mellott entered his 2nd yr. as a Lady Panthers Asst. Coach. Mellott joins the program from Adams State University where he was as an asst. for 2 seasons. Prior to ASU, he was an asst. for 1 season (2017-18) at Har-Ber High, and left with head coach Jamie Green for ASU. Before Har-Ber, Mellott was the head coach for Leavenworth High School (2014-17). He led the Lady Pioneers to a 64-11 record in 3 seasons, a Class 5 state title in 2015, and a state semifinals appearance in all three years. Mellott was named the KBCA 2015 5A Coach of the Year and was selected to serve as the 2016 head coach of the Missouri-Kansas High School All-Star Game.
